The Handbook. A (digital and printed) resource that will contain pedagogical sessions targeting organizations and trainers involved in offering migrants and refugees support, green/ecological enterprises, and migrants in order to develop their competencies and raise awareness about the issue of migrants' integration on the labor market, and use the methodology in this regard.

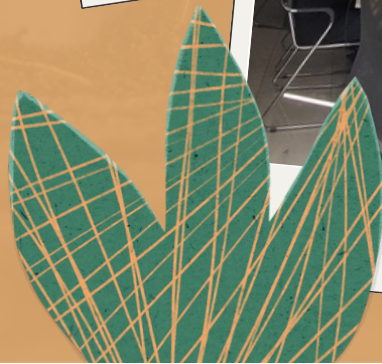
The Toolkit. An interactive and engaging online collection of educational resources, dedicated to trainers, educators and organisations in order to identify and evaluate migrants' and refugees' vocational skills, to improve their language skills, to contribute to their integration process by offering orientation & guidance, and to build career paths fitting their competencies.

Let's get to know our consortium...



As an adult education provider, AFIDEL mainly runs training and accompaniment actions, focusing its fields of intervention on three areas of skills and competencies: the accompaniment of young adults to employment and qualification, vocational training, and integration engineering. Based in Saint-Gaudens, a small town in the South West of France, AFIDEL acts in the districts Toulouse South and Comminges - Pyrenees (South of the Department Haute-Garonne, France), both rural territories. The learners are essentially young adults (18-26 years old), out of the school system, and without any degree or qualification. The objective of the measures is to allow these persons to get vocational training and/or employment. The training courses include 'basic skills' modules preparation for job qualification, citizenship and eco-citizenship, ICT, career guidance, communication, and team working, and dynamisation. We are 18 employees: 3 administrative staff, 3 teachers (language training) working with migrants and refugees, and 12 job counselors who take care of social accompaniment and vocational training.

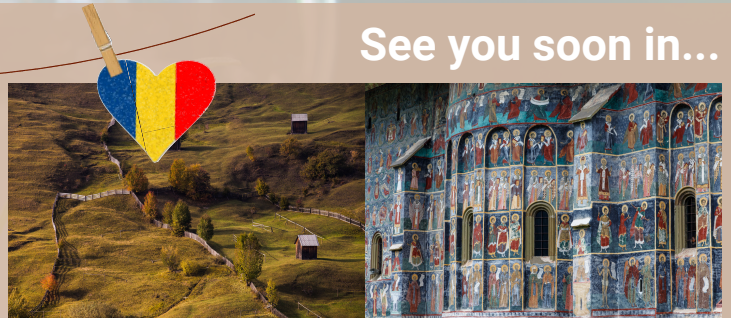
Empowering migrants...
