This autumn, two workshops took place in Trieste (Italy), organised by the Italian partner - Duemilauno Agenzia Sociale in collaboration with the Social Cooperative - Lister Sartoria Sociale, working in the field of textile recycling and transformation.

Thanks to the Bora wind which strongly blows in Trieste, broken umbrellas can have a second life!



Duemilauno Agenzia Sociale involved migrant youngsters in two workshops during which they developed their skills, including the language ones.

With the involvement of Maria's World Foundation from Bulgaria, the participants easily communicated on their professional needs, and with the support of the graphical tools, they had the possibility to run the activities in at least 4 different languages: Italian, Urdu, Persian, and Bulgarian!



Let's get to know our consortium...



Bucovina Institute is an adult education NGO from Suceava, a city in the Northern part of Romania, founded in 2011. Our mission is to support the sustainable development of the communities in Romania, Ukraine, and the Republic of Moldova, by establishing partnerships for learning, organizing, and conducting training programs that promote continuous education.

We work with youngsters and adults from rural areas, migrants, minorities, and people with disabilities, to ensure their access to the labour market and all forms of learning.

During the last 10 years, Bucovina Institute has gained expertise in implementing various of projects that promote employment and social inclusion including Erasmus+, EEA & Norway Grants and ESF.

We work with migrants and refugees who often face challenges in entering the labour market. Our work on various national and european projects implemented during the last years consisted in supporting migrants in terms of socio-professional integration, and development of skills.

Lastly, in the spring of 2022, we've set up the Center for Social Emergencies for Ukrainian refugees, especially for mothers and their children, who benefit from counseling services, support groups, language courses, art classes, and many more.
